We don't represent one fleet — we hand-pick crewed catamarans, monohulls, motor yachts, bareboats and day boats from across the islands so you sail on the right yacht with the right crew for your trip.

Based on the ground in Bequia and the UK, we book the yacht, arrange transfers, provisioning, chefs, shore tours and the small details that turn a holiday into the one your guests still talk about a year later.

This collection is a starting point. Tell us when you'd like to come and who with, and we'll come back inside 24 hours with three to five yachts shortlisted for you — with honest opinions on which we'd pick.

THE CRUISING GROUND

The Grenadines

A 60-mile string of islands running south from St Vincent to Grenada. Short sailing legs, reliable trade winds, calm leeward anchorages and some of the clearest water in the Caribbean.

From the buzz of Bequia to the quiet polish of Mustique, the horseshoe reef of the Tobago Cays and the kitesurfing wind on Union — nine islands, one short sail apart, in a marine park barely changed in a generation.

Northern Grenadines

St Vincent

Rainforests, waterfalls and the start of every charter. Kingstown market, Pirates of the Caribbean filming locations, La Soufrière hike.

Bequia

The friendly island. Admiralty Bay, the Old Hegg Turtle Sanctuary, Friday-night fish fry on Lower Bay.

Mustique

Private-island glamour, quietly done. Basil's Bar, Macaroni Beach, celebrity-spotting without the crowds.

Canouan

Beach-club polish a mile from empty bays. Glossy Bay Marina, Soho Beach House, private-jet access mid-charter.



Southern Grenadines

Mayreau

Salt Whistle Bay's half-moon of sand — one of the most photographed anchorages in the world.

Tobago Cays

Five uninhabited islands inside a horseshoe reef. Snorkel with turtles, lobster BBQ on the beach. The single best day of almost every charter.

Union Island

Kitesurfing capital and Grenadines crossroads. Happy Island bar, Chatham Bay sunsets, easy international transfers.

Petit St Vincent

PSV — the southern luxury secret. Paddleboard across to Mopion sandbar, dinner under stars with no light pollution.



Ways to charter

Crewed catamarans

Our most-booked way to sail the Grenadines. Stable, spacious, with a captain, chef and water toys included. From 4 to 12 guests.

Bareboat

Take the helm yourself. Catamarans and monohulls based in Blue Lagoon and Bequia, with an optional skipper on request.

Shore cruises

Hotel-based short tours from Canouan or St Vincent — a taste of the Grenadines without sleeping aboard.

Crewed monohulls & motor yachts

Classic sailing yachts for guests who want to be at the helm with a pro on board, and fully-crewed motor yachts for fast island-hopping.

Day boats

RIBs, day cats and day sailers for snorkelling, transfers and sunset sails. Half-day and full-day bookings from St Vincent, Bequia, Mustique and Union.





LIFE ON BOARD

Long lunches, quiet bays

Mornings start slowly. Coffee on deck, a swim before breakfast, then a short sail to the next bay. Your chef builds the day's menu around what came off the boats that morning — lobster, mahi, snapper, plantains, mango.

Afternoons are for snorkelling with turtles in the Tobago Cays, paddleboarding around Mopion, or doing nothing at all. Sunsets are at Basil's Bar on Mustique, Happy Island on Union, or your own cockpit with the boat to yourselves.

We brief your crew on what you like before you arrive — honeymoon, family with small kids, four couples who want to party, eight friends celebrating a birthday. Every charter is shaped around the people on it.



Sample 7-night itinerary

- **Day 1 — St Vincent → Bequia**
Board in Blue Lagoon, short sail south to Admiralty Bay. Sundowners ashore, dinner at Mac's.
- **Day 2 — Bequia → Mustique**
Mooring in Britannia Bay, lunch at Basil's, afternoon at Macaroni Beach.
- **Day 3 — Mustique → Canouan**
Sail to Charlestown Bay, beach club lunch at Pink Sands.
- **Day 4 — Canouan → Tobago Cays**
The highlight day. Snorkel with turtles, lobster BBQ on the beach at sunset.
- **Day 5 — Tobago Cays → Mayreau**
Salt Whistle Bay for swimming, walk into town for the view across the cays.
- **Day 6 — Mayreau → Union → PSV**
Clear in at Clifton, sundowner at Happy Island, overnight on a PSV mooring.
- **Day 7 — PSV → Mopion → Bequia**
Paddleboard to Mopion sandbar at dawn, long sail north.
- **Day 8 — Bequia → St Vincent**
Breakfast in Admiralty Bay, short hop back for disembark.

Itineraries are illustrative — we tailor every charter around weather, group and preferences.



How it works

1 · Tell us about your trip

Group size, dates, budget, and what you'd like the trip to feel like.

2 · Three to five yachts shortlisted

Inside 24 hours we send a hand-picked shortlist with honest comparison.

3 · Hold & confirm

We hold your first choice while you decide. 50% deposit confirms. Final balance 60 days out.

4 · Pre-charter planning

Preference sheet, dietary needs, shore tours, transfers, helicopter, chef menu — all sorted before you fly.

5 · On charter

We're on the ground in Bequia and reachable 24/7. We check in but stay out of the way.

6 · After

We ask for your honest feedback, and start planning next year.





GETTING HERE

How to reach the islands

Argyle International (SVD), St Vincent — the main gateway. Direct from Miami, New York JFK, Toronto and connecting services from London via Barbados.

Union Island (UNI) — small regional airport, useful for one-way charters or quick crew changes.

Mustique & Canouan — private-jet accessible; ideal for mid-charter guest joins.

Connections via Barbados (BGI), St Lucia (UVF) and Grenada (GND), with short regional hops onward.

We arrange every transfer — private cars, water taxis, helicopters — from the moment you land.
